



St Barnabas Northolt Park

Proposal: To remove our old wooden chairs, and replace them with more space efficient high stacking chairs.

In 2022 we were granted permission to replace a number of our old wooden chairs with more comfortable and sturdy chairs in the central part of the nave. At the time we had planned to retain a number of the old wooden chairs for those occasions when we might welcome a larger congregation to church, e.g. for a wedding or a funeral, as additional seating.

Unfortunately these wooden chairs do not stack well and take up a considerable amount of space within the church, creating a cluttered and untidy appearance and limiting the space we can use for other things; e.g. sharing hospitality together after the service or for our children's ministry.

We wish to dispose of these last remaining wooden chairs and to purchase approx. 60 high stacking chairs. These would provide additional seating, when required, in the side aisles and at the very back of the church. We would look to match them, as closely as possible, with the colour of our current chairs.

We will approach Church Antiques again to explore whether they might wish to purchase any of these wooden chairs as they did previously.



We are looking to purchase new chairs of this style, to replace the wooden chairs we wish to dispose of. These can stack 10 high, whereas the current wooden chairs can only stack 2 high – and so take up a considerable amount of space within the church building which could be better used.
